

BAHAMAS
NEW SPORT FISHING RULES
Effective JANUARY 1, 2007

The changes are as follows:

- six crawfish per vessel – August through March;
- prohibits the catching of conch;
- twenty pounds of demersal fish (such as groupers, snappers, etc.) per vessel;
- six pelagic species (dolphins, kingfish, wahoo, tuna) per vessel; and
- all fish retained must be kept with head and tail intact while aboard the vessel or transported by air to facilitate identification during inspection.

There are exceptions to the stated catch limits for persons participating in authorized fishing tournaments where the approved rules of the tournament set other catch limits
